It seems like April has arrived in the blink of an eye. The wolves certainly enjoyed their winter wonderland on the few occasions with snow, but now nearly everyone is starting to shed their winter wear and we know that hot days are just around the corner.

Fall and winter has kept everyone incredibly busy around the Sanctuary. There are so many projects currently going on and so many that still need to be done. We hope to continue to build more enclosures, update some of our older ones and allow for more access to our wonderful family of wolves. Since our last letter we have completed some major projects, like the addition of a beautiful wooden porch to the information center that has allowed for easier access to all our visitors. We have also put in a new enclosure that houses our most recent pack, the Penny Pack.

The Penny Pack is home to four playful youngsters: Rogue, Jasper, Liberty and Sky. They have a nearly insatiable need to bounce about, chase one another and just stir up a great time among themselves. Liberty and Sky are a couple of newcomers to the Sanctuary. They both arrived last July and have formed a strong bond with Rogue and Jasper. The Penny Pack received their name from Liberty who was released by his owner in Pennypack Park in Philadelphia. There he roamed for months feeding off scraps people threw him, or from cat and dog dishes people placed in their yards for their own pets.

Our caretaker and volunteers were called in to rescue the poor guy before any mistakes occurred and wildlife agents would have to put him down. After a few days of trying and many failed attempts, the PA Game Commission managed to trap Liberty and brought him to the Sanctuary. After health scan at the vet, we found that Liberty was severely malnourished from his time

Along with our new arrivals, we also had to say good-bye to some greatly loved wolves that passed away this year. Delilah, the omega in Smokey's Pack; our beautiful wolf with one blue and one orange eye, passed away in February. We also must say farewell to Kydro, who was only with us a short time, but immensely loved nonetheless.



The care and welfare of our wolves is paramount to the Sanctuary and we are always working towards giving our animals more room to roam and less stress in captivity by enlarging their enclosures and ensuring ample separation between the packs. The only way for us to provide such a high level of care and room for our wolves is by visitors like you. Without your help we would not be able to take in more neglected and mistreated wolves from people unable to care for them.

For many wolves kept as pets there are only two options when the state or federal authorities get involved: euthanasia or a sanctuary, and we here at the Wolf Sanctuary of PA will do anything in
